


QUARTERLY Rewind

Updates on the Goose Harbour Wind Farm Project

Summer and Fall activity on the PHP Wind Project has been substantial. We have seen water crossings, roads, turbine sites and all foundation work completed, and the beginnings of the switching station and power collection systems. Meanwhile, the turbine blades, hubs, drivetrains and towers have been manufactured.

All 24 turbine foundation bases and pedestals are poured, with each foundation nearly 28 meters across, to anchor the largest wind turbines installed in North America. All indications forecast on-time turbine delivery targets in Q1 and Q2, with installation completed in Q4 of 2026.

- Developed an EUDR Due Diligence Statement for customers


